## Big Bertha Pepper



Very large bell pepper. Ripens to red. Large plants are disease resistant.



## Capsicum annum 'Big Bertha' (days sow to harvest 70)

- **Use**: Big Bertha produces thick, crisp peppers that are extremely sweet and mature dark green to shiny red. They don't produce many seeds, making them excellent for slicing. For maximum flavor, eat the same day they are picked. Easy to grow in any garden, give them plenty of sunlight and water. Tobacco Mosaic Virus resistant.
- Scoville heat units: 0/ No heat Exposure/Soil: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
  - *Growth:* Grows 1-2' tall and 1-1.5' wide.
  - *Hardiness:* Zone 9-11, Annual
  - Foliage: Small, lacy leaves.
  - *Flower:* These large, thick-walled sweet peppers are perfect for stuffing and in salads. Fruits are 7" square.

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
