

# Compadre Pepper



*Capsicum annum 'Compadre' Moderate to Hot  
(5,000-30,000 Scoville)*

**You can grow  
them in a pot  
on your patio!**

- **Use:** Plant produces high yields of large bullet shaped Jalapeno peppers. Tolerant to alkaline soils as well as low and high temperatures in comparison to other Jalapeno hybrids. Does well in stressful weather. Disease Resistant: TMV, PVY and Anthocyanin. This hybrid pepper features an ability to produce high yields with excellent fruit uniformity, and has consistently offered smooth, low cracking, quality peppers in trials
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 1-2' tall and 1-1.5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, lacy leaves.
- **Flower/Fruit:** Peppers are hot, have thick flesh, and turn from shiny green to red when mature.
