

Sangria Ornamental Pepper



You can grow them in a pot on your patio or as a bedding plant! Great for creating seasonal decorations.

Capsicum annuum 'Sangria'

- **Use:** This is a decorative pepper plant that adds a pop of long-lasting color with its purple fruits that gradually change to bright red. While the peppers are edible, and lovely in fall decorations.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-12" tall and 1-1.5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, leaves
- **Flower:** Produces a continuous display of both purple and red peppers. Child-safe, non-pungent variety is ideal for indoor/outdoor use.
