Eureka Lemon Tree







Citrus limon 'Eureka'

- <u>Use:</u> One of the most popular lemon varieties grown today, it is a vigorous grower and tends to bear while still young with fruit arriving late winter through early summer. The prolific yellow lemons are small-to-medium size, with tender, juicy fruit and few to no seeds, and the rind has prominent ridges and is full of fragrant oil that gives it an intense citrus scent.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but good draining soil is a must. They are always hungry so be sure to give them lots of citrus fertilizer!
- Growth: Moderate grower to 4-7 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide
- *Hardiness:* Zone 9-11; 30 degrees F, must be grown indoors in winter when temps below 50 degrees for reliable fruit production.
- Foliage: Evergreen, variegated cream & green foliage
- Flower: Fragrant 1 1/2 2" white flowers,
- <u>Fruit</u>: A true lemon 2-3" wide, not a hybrid like Meyer lemon, and its juice and zest are often made into baked goods like lemon meringue pie or lemon bread. It also makes delicious lemonade and other drinks.
