- **Use:** If you're looking for a great-tasting home-grown lemon but live in a colder climate, look no further than the Harvey Lemon Tree which is a favorite among commercial growers. Combining the great benefits of other varieties with the extra perk of cold hardiness, the Harvey Lemon Tree has it all.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but good draining soil is a must. They are always hungry so be sure to give them lots of citrus fertilizer at least every 6 months!
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 12-14 feet tall and 8-10 feet wide outdoors, but can be kept smaller in a pot.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11; 20 degrees F, must be grown indoors in winter when temps below 50 degrees for reliable fruit production.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen Fragrant green foliage
- **Flower:** Fragrant 1 1/2 - 2" white flowers,
- **Fruit:** Renowned for its abundant production of medium to large-sized lemons with smooth, bright yellow skin, this citrus tree is a must-have for lemon lovers. It's perfect for nearly any culinary use - but it's much hardier than similar lemon varieties. That means you get tasty, nearly seedless tart treats of your own, from your own backyard, without any guesswork in growing. Produces September to March.
