

Persian / Bearss Lime Tree



We love the fragrance of the blossoms! Enjoy this seedless lime with bright juicy acidity and a touch of sweetness.

Citrus x latifolia

- **Use:** Also known as Tahitian Lime it is a triploid cross between Key lime (*Citrus × aurantiifolia*) and lemon (*Citrus × limon*). A seedless lime that is less acidic and slightly sweeter compared to other limes, a popular cultivar for use in Margaritas. Also excellent for culinary uses, such as desserts, beverages or to add flavor to savory dishes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry and must have great drainage. Citrus are heavy feeders so fertilize often with a citrus fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 8-10 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide in a large pot.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; 30 degrees F, must be grown indoors in winter for reliable fruit production. Can be grow outdoors when nite temps are above 50 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, glossy green foliage. Relatively no thorns.
- **Flower:** Fragrant 1 1/2 - 2" white flowers,
- **Fruit:** Produces fruit throughout the year, although most heavily in the summer months. Medium (2-2.5") sized fruit have a green skin, which turns yellow when fully ripe.
