Citrus x latifolia

- <u>Use:</u> Also known as Tahitian Lime it is a triploid cross between Key lime (Citrus × aurantiifolia) and lemon (Citrus × limon). A seedless lime that is less acidic and slightly sweeter compared to other limes, a popular cultivar for use in Margaritas. Also excellent for culinary uses, such as desserts, beverages or to add flavor to savory dishes.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry and must have great drainage. Citrus are heavy feeders so fertilize often with a citrus fertilizer.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower to 8-10 feet tall and 4-6 feet wide in a large pot.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-11; 30 degrees F, must be grown indoors in winter for reliable fruit production. Can be grow outdoors when nite temps are above 50 degrees.
- *Foliage*: Evergreen, glossy green foliage. Relatively no thorns.
- *Flower:* Fragrant 1 1/2 2" white flowers,
- <u>Fruit</u>: Produces fruit throughout the year, although most heavily in the summer months. Medium (2-2.5")sized fruit have a green skin, which turns yellow when fully ripe.
