

Patio Snacker Cucumber



Cucumbers should be planted in a section of your garden that receives full sun and has evenly moist soil. If your garden space is limited, cucumbers will do just fine in full sun on a patio or deck in a 5 gallon or larger container.

Cucumis melo var 'Patio Snacker'

- **Use:** Perfect vining variety for large containers with trellises. Patio Snacker is a well branched, short, vining variety perfect for large containers with small trellises. This fast-growing plant produces early, continuous high yields of 8-in. (20-cm) dark green fruit with great flavor and a nice crunch.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 3-5' tall and 12" wide. Great on a large trellis.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual,
- **Fruit/Flower:** Dark green-skinned, 8" fruits have a good flavor, crunchy texture and a bitter-free peel - great for straight-from-the-vine eating. Free-flowering, monoecious plants are high yielding with continuous harvests. 39 days to harvest
