High yielding, glossy and smooth fruit with an attractive yellow color. Longer harvest and improved fruit quality thanks to excellent disease protection. WMV, ZYMV



## Cucurbita pepo 'Gold Prize'

- <u>Use:</u> Goldprize Squash is a hybrid, straightneck variety that produces glossy, yellow fruits. Excellent disease packaged and increased productivity.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun and try to keep water off the leaves. Water the garden to provide a uniform moisture supply to the crop. Keep the leaves and fruit dry when watering and avoid overhead sprinkler irrigation. Water sufficiently to moisten the soil to a depth of 6 inches. Light sprinklings will encourage shallow rooting of the plants. The critical period for moisture is during fruit set and fruit development.
- **Growth**: Grows 6' or more wide.
- Hardiness/Harvest Time: Zone 10-11 Annual / Yields in 30 days from transplant. Squash and pumpkins can be grown with black plastic mulch. The black plastic absorbs the sun's warmth, allowing the soil to warm quickly. Also, google tips to prevent squash borer and be preventive.
- <u>Fruit</u> Delivers a very productive, high-quality yield with the advantage of improved yellow color in a smaller fruit that consumers demand. Higher yields.
