Fragaria 'Ozark Beauty'

- **Use:** Ozark Beauty strawberry plants have become one of the best-selling of all commercially sold everbearing strawberries in large part to its overall robustness and adaptability. This everbearing strawberry delivers a large initial harvest and then bears a steady crop throughout the season. The vigorous plants are easy to grow and resistant to leaf spot and leaf scorch. Self-pollinating.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun, but will take a little shade. Try to keep water off the leaves when watering. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Fertilize with a bloom food.
- **Growth:** Continues to trail all season long!
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous ; Lovely green leaves.
- **Flower:** Fragrant blossoms produce sweet red berries! Since Ozark Beauty strawberry plants are everbearers, planting them can yield two crops of strawberries: one in the late spring/early summer and another in the fall. Did you know... this strawberry produces plenty of fruit for your favorite jams, jellies and pies—but are also almost irresistible fresh from the garden!
