

Lolla Rosa Lettuce



Lactuca Lolla Rosa

- **Use:** There is a bewildering diversity of lettuce types, with more appearing all the time. Butterheads are soft loose-hearted varieties, crispheads or icebergs are large dense and crunchy, cos types have upright, crisp leaves, and loose-leaf do not make hearts but are gathered as dense leafy heads or individual leaves are picked over a long period. 'Lollo Rosso' has very pretty frilly reddish-pink leaves. The Royal Horticultural Society has given it its prestigious Award of Garden Merit (AGM).
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun and keep the soil evenly moist.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-8" tall and wide and larger. 30 days to baby lettuce; 55 days to full size.
- **Hardiness/Harvest Time:** Annual / Yields in less than 90 days.
- **Fruit:** A lettuce with mainly red colored leaves that add a hint of colour to your salad as well as having a good flavour.



A highly decorative as well as tasty variety, forming a tight head of frilly dark red leaves with a good flavour, which will stand in good condition over a long period. Cut as a head or pick a few leaves at a time. Excellent resistance to mildew.
