

# Bumble Bee Sunrise Tomato

## *Lycopersicum 'Bumble Bee Sunrise' Indeterminate*

- **Use:** Three super-sweet, crack-resistant cherry varieties create a rainbow of color for fresh snacking. Plants produce all season, tolerating cool nights and hot days. Purple is a dusky purple with metallic green striping. Grow these crack-resistant, round cherry tomatoes along with Pink Bumble Bee and Purple Bumble Bee to serve a rainbow of color for fresh snacking. Plants produce all season long, tolerating cool nights and hot days. Sunrise Bumble Bee offers gorgeous color, inside and out! The yellow fruit has red exterior stripes and pink interior marbling. This one offers a mix of both sweet and tangy taste. 60-70 days.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 3' tall
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, lacy leaves.
- **Fruit:** **Lovely gold fruit marbled with pink stripes on the inside and out.** So pretty to look at you won't want to eat them...but such excellent sweet flavor that you can't resist! Crack-resistant, round cherry tomatoes are great for fresh snacking. Plants produce all season long, tolerating cool nights and hot days.
