

Carolina Gold Tomato



Lycopersicum 'Carolina Gold'

- **Use:** 71 Days
(VFF) Resistant to Gray Wall, a common problem with many varieties. Extra-large fruits, bigger than Mountain Gold, with yellow-gold, deep oblate fruits. The tomatoes ripen uniformly on vigorous, widely adaptable plants resistant to Verticillium and Fusarium Wilt. Requires staking for optimal performance. Determinate.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 36" tall and 36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Lacy leaves
- **Fruit:** Very flavorful, golden-yellow fruits are low in acidity. Extra-large fruits are meaty with a sweet, mild flavor. Testing indicates they may contain more readily absorbable lycopene than red tomatoes.
