

# Pink German Johnson Tomato



## HEIRLOOM

- Known as one of the most famous heirloom tomatoes
- A low-maintenance plant
- Juicy, large tomatoes perfect for snacking!

- ***Lycopersicum 'German Johnson Pink' Indeterminate***
- **Use**: The most highly treasured heirloom pink in the South, where its mild tomato flavor and superior yields are appreciated. Vigorous vines with potato leaf foliage yield pink-skinned, rough, meaty fruits.
- **Exposure/Soil**: FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our peat blend.
- **Growth**: Grows 36" tall and 36" wide. Plant tomatoes 2"-3" deeper than current soil line for a sturdy plant.
- **Hardiness**: 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage**: Small, lacy leaves.
- **Fruit**: A potato leaf version of the heirloom German Johnson. Vigorous, potato leaf vines produce mild-flavored, meaty, rough, 12 to 24 ounce fruits with pink skin, yellow shoulders, and low acid flavor. May contain a small percentage of regular leaf plants. Highly rated for flavor and yield.
