- <u>Use</u>: Heirloom Marriage hybrids cross two heirlooms to produce earlier and more fruit, with great flavor and fewer blemishes than the parents. Big, pink fruit is a cross of Big Dwarf and Brandywine.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our peat mix.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 5-7' tall and 3-4' wide or more depending on type. Plant tomatoes 2"-3" deeper than current soil line for a sturdy plant.
- *Hardiness:* 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- Foliage: Small, lacy leaves.
- <u>Fruit:</u> Big, pink fruit with outstanding flavour is a cross of Big Dwarf and Brandywine. Heirloom tomatoes are proven to have an aroma, flavor and freshness money can't buy.
