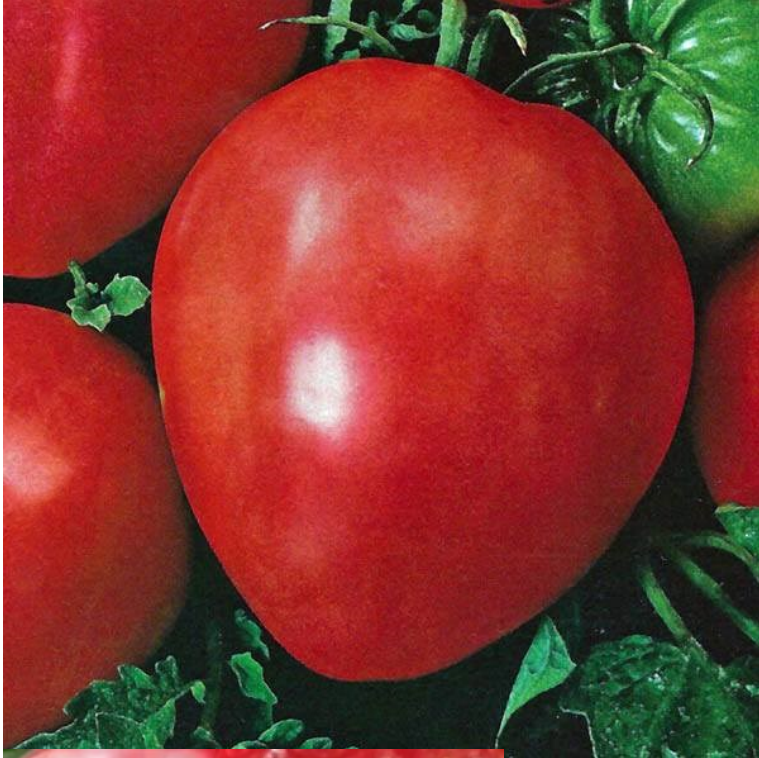


Oxheart Red Tomato



The fruits are large, red in color, and as their name implies, heart-shaped.

- ***Lycopersicum 'Oxheart Red' (Indeterminate)***
- **Use:** An heirloom tomato that first appeared in the 1920s. It is prized for attractive heart shape, sweet, rich flavour, and meaty texture. The large fruits have really substantial flesh and small seed cavities so they are perfect for sauces.
- **Exposure/Soil:** FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our PRO_MIX. 80 days.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6' tall and 3' wide. Plant tomatoes 2"-3" deeper than current soil line for a sturdy plant. Will need staking.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Plants have "potato leaf" foliage.
- **Fruit:** The plant produces good yields of 1 to 2 lb red tomatoes. These heart-shaped tomatoes are sweet, juicy, and very flavorful. Perfect for salads and making tomato sauce. An excellent choice for home gardens.
