

Purple Boy Tomato



Don't forget to plant Marigold with your Tomatoes to keep away the bugs!



***Lycopersicum 'Purple Boy'* Indeterminate type**

- **Use:** This new tomato combines all the flavor of the heirloom Cherokee Purple but with an improved disease resistance package. Its deep violet color, intense rich flavor, and stunning violet purple hues, offers that true homegrown tomato tang. Where Cherokee Purple was under high disease pressure and did not grow well, this hybrid can be grown and enjoyed all summer long.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 36" tall and 36" wide. Set plants 2 to 2 1/2 feet apart.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, lacy leaves.
- **Flower:** The Purple Boy hybrid tomato is resistant to nematodes, verticillium wilt, Fusarium wilt and tobacco mosaic. Slightly ridged and very symmetrically shaped, these tomatoes combine juiciness with a strong tomato tang, the type unknown to those rock-hard supermarket varieties.
