Lycopersicum Roma

- **Use:** The classic Italian paste tomato. Bright red, plum shaped, paste-type fruits with meaty interiors. Determinate plants. Ready to pick about 76 days after plants are set out. GARDEN HINTS: Fertilize when first fruits form to increase yield. Water deeply once a week during very dry weather. 70 days. *Lycopersicon esculentum*. (F1) Plant produces high yields of 2 oz red pear shaped tomatoes. The tomatoes have excellent flavor and have extra long shelf life. Excellent for salads, and for making sauce and paste. Suitable for containers and patio pots. A variety from the USA. Determinate. Disease Resistant: VFN
- **Intermediate type**
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 10-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Lacy leaves
