

Sweet Cocktail Tomato



Juicy, sweet, and versatile, cocktail tomatoes range from 2-4 oz — bigger than cherries and grapes, but smaller than slicers. Perfect halved or served whole on salads, cocktail tomatoes are often called saladette or salad tomatoes.

Lycopersicum 'Sweet Cocktail'

- **Use:** The sweet cocktail tomato offers a uniquely compact plant with great-tasting fruit! The lush tomatoes have soft skin with an extra sweet flavor. The plant has an upward growth habit and can grow up to twice its original height once its first fruit turns color. It performs well both indoors and outdoors so come winter, you can bring your tomato plant inside.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 24-36" tall and 24-36" wide. Set plants 2 to 2 1/2 feet apart.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, lacy leaves.
- **Flower:** With their vibrant flavor, firm texture, and convenient size, they are also superb for fresh snacking, roasting, and incorporating into pasta and other dishes.
