

Sweet Million Tomato



Don't forget to plant Marigolds with your Tomatoes to keep away the bugs!

Lycopersicum 'Sweet Million'

- **Use:** (F1) 65-75 days. Trial ground visitors can't get enough of this one! They keep sneaking back for these flavor packed cherry tomatoes. The indeterminate 3 foot tall plants produce 1-1 1/2 inch fruit in grape-like clusters. A truss of these two bite size tomatoes is welcome next to any mixed greens salad. Very disease resistant. F1, F2, TMV.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 3 ' tall
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Small, lacy leaves.
