

Tumbling Tom Yellow Tomato



A great choice for small space gardens (where it can hang above the "ground" Tomatoes!), urban balconies, and any other bright sunny setting, Tumbling Tom is well-branched, about 6 to 8



inches wide, and vigorously productive. Plant 2 or 3 in a 10- or 12-inch basket and you'll be rolling in Tomatoes before you know it!

- **Use:** Weeping habit trails 2 feet from baskets and tubs! 70 days to maturity from setting out transplants. Determinate; weeping habit. No more staking, stooping, and searching for Tomatoes in the garden -- Tumbling Tom puts big handfuls of luscious low acid cherries right at eye level! This lovely "edible ornamental" is just perfect for hanging baskets, windowboxes, and tall containers where you want to show off the color and vigor of your favorite Tomato! Grow it just as you would any other Tomato, but don't worry about stakes, cages, root nematode, and other pests of the soil! Tumbling Tom is above it all!
- **Exposure/Soil:** FULL SUN! Soak to depth of 6 to 10 inches when watering. They need at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day. Tomatoes hate red clay so use a good soil such as our PRO_MIX.
- **Growth:** This plant has a weeping habit, so it dangles about 2 feet over the sides of containers, for all the world as pretty as any spreading Petunia! **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Dark green quilted leaves.
- **Fruit:** Just like Tumbling Tom Red tomatoes, this yellow version produce full hanging baskets of 1 to 2" fruit but they are a golden-yellow in color.
