Mentha arvensis 'Thai'

- <u>Use:</u> Cook with your own fresh herbs! Purple flowers and aromatic leaves have a hint of caraway. Strong spreading grower benefits from regular pinching.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: They love full sun, but be sure to keep them well watered, but not drowning. Pinch tips back occasionally to produce a bushy plant! Use slow release fertilizer for best results
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 1-2 ft tall and continues to spread. Excellent for use in containers. Can be very vigorous.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-9; Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Dark green leaves and black stems.
- Flower: Purple flowers in fall.
