Mentha arvensis 'Thai'

- **Use:** Cook with your own fresh herbs! Purple flowers and aromatic leaves have a hint of caraway. Strong spreading grower benefits from regular pinching.
- **Exposure/Soil:** They love full sun, but be sure to keep them well watered, but not drowning. Pinch tips back occasionally to produce a bushy plant! Use slow release fertilizer for best results
- **Growth:** Grows 1-2 ft tall and continues to spread. Excellent for use in containers. Can be very vigorous.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves and black stems.
- **Flower:** Purple flowers in fall.
