- <u>Use:</u> Although the foliage is aromatic, it is not of the pungency and quality expected for culinary oreganos and is usually not usually used in cooking. Long blooming, the foliage has a spicy aromatic scent. See more at: http://www.bluestoneperennials.com/ORKB.html#sthash.ktX1frfw.dpuf
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers full to part sun. Water the plants during extended dry spells, but be sure not to over-water, as sweet marjoram likes a slightly dry climate.
- **Growth:** Will grow to about 3-6" inches tall and 6-12" wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 6-9, Perennial; Must be mulched in the winter.
- Foliage: Deciduous; Prominent veins found in the heart-shaped blue green leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Unique, drooping, pink-bracted, hop-like flowers bloom in whorls from summer to fall.
