

Russian 26 Pomegranate Bush/ Tree



Hardier than the Wonderful and known to survive temperatures down to 5 degrees. Self-pollinated.



Punica granatum '26'

- **Use:** One of the most cold and heat tolerant Pomegranate. Experiences no damage from freeze damage down to 3 degrees F!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. As long as it is properly established, it is moderately drought tolerant.
- **Growth:** Growing up to 10 feet tall and wide with a naturally rounded shape. It can be grown as a large shrub or "limbed up" to form a small tree.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6a-11; Tree/ Small shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small green leaves.
- **Flower:** In spring, it will produce bright orange single flowers that really light up the garden. Self fruitful. That being said, two plants increases fruit production. The flowers are followed by large, bright orange-red fruit that are filled with delectable, nutrient-packed, dark red seeds that are amazingly sweet - said to be the sweetest of any Pomegranate!
