Punica grantum 'Wonderful'

- **Use:** Improved variety with fountain-like branches that display large orange-red blooms in summer and large, burnished, delicious red fruit in early fall. A popular variety for making pomegranate juice, Beautiful as shrub, small tree or espalier. Fruits best in warm semi-arid climates. Pomegranates are used in cooking, baking, juices, and smoothies, and alcoholic beverages such as martinis and wine.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. As long as it is properly established, it is moderately drought tolerant.
- **Growth:** Growing 10' tall and wide quickly.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-11; Tree/ Small shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small green leaves.
