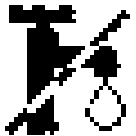


Roman Beauty Rosemary



Rosemarinus officinalis 'Roman Beauty' PP18192

- **Use:** It quickly forms an upright hedge of aromatic needle-like foliage that has a very good flavor for culinary use. Profuse clear-blue flowers provide additional landscape value. Well-suited to regular pruning for small topiaries. Plant in multiples for a low, fragrant hedge that will keep you in fresh herbs year round.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Must have good drainage as it can't stand soggy feet.
- Water regularly when top 3in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Perhaps the hardiest of all varieties, it will reach 2-3' and widths of 18" to 24". Semi-upright habit with slightly arching stems.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-10; Shrub /herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The spicy scented, mid-green, needle-like foliage provides a wonderful backdrop to violet flowers from spring to early summer.
- **Flowers:** The small blue flowers that appear in mid summer are edible as well, and make a nice garnish for salads.



As an herb, Rosemary is used to flavor meat dishes, and condiments.
