Decorative and edible, this dwarf blackberry plant will even liven up your patio or entryway. Grows well in containers!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full sun (with irrigation) -partial shade and a cool mulch may be beneficial. This cultivar prefers well-drained, moderately fertile soil.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 3-4' tall and wide. Canes are more erect than other thorn less varieties and can be grown without a trellis when primo canes are tipped at 42" to control primo cane length and encourage lateral shoot growth.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. In spring and summer, the leaves are shiny dark green above and gray-green below, turning to burgundy in fall and winter.
- <u>Flowers</u>: Fall-bearing (everbearing) primocane with a summer crop of firm and juicy berries. Floricane berries ripen in July. Primocane berries ripen in September through frost. Self-pollinating.
