

Fall Gold Raspberry



Rubus idaeus 'Fall Gold'

- **Use:** A rare, exciting self-fertile gold raspberry with the same delicious sweet taste of red varieties, and with the ability to produce two crops each season.. After a late summer to fall harvest, a second crop arrives the following spring on the same canes. Excellent fresh or for preserves and pies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** This cultivar prefers sun and well-drained, moderately fertile soil, but unlike most other red raspberries does not require a cold winter and gradual spring to produce good fruit. Partial shade and a cool mulch may be beneficial.
- **Growth:** Rapid growth to 4-6' tall and wide. Vigorous, productive canes.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; In spring and summer, the leaves are shiny dark green above and gray-green below, turning to burgundy in fall and winter.
- **Flowers:** Everbearing. Large to very large, conical, non-crumbling, extremely sweet, rather soft, golden berries. Excellent for fresh eating and processing.
