

# Golden Tower Elderberry



## *Sambucus nigra* 'Jandeboer001'

- **Use:** Golden Tower elderberry has shimmering golden, lacey leaves that resemble a Japanese maple. Its dense, columnar habit makes an ideal focal plant in the landscape. White flower clusters are produced in spring, followed by clusters of red berries providing a beautiful contrast against the foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to sun, but part sun better in the hot South.
- **Growth:** Grows 10' tall and 4' wide. Elderberries look great unpruned, but they take well to pruning too. They are best pruned after blooming, although if you are growing it primarily as a foliage plant, it can be pruned in early spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 Shrub; Protect from hot summer sun.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Showy, yellow-green foliage. Its color is like gold glistening in the sun! The leaves have a gorgeous, deeply incised shape. Pretty, white flower clusters appear in summer.
- **Flower:** White flower clusters are produced in spring, followed by clusters of red berries providing a beautiful contrast against the foliage. Berries may be consumed when cooked.
