

Millionaire Eggplant



Long, slender fruits, growing up to 12" long, have smooth, tender, brilliant black skin and nearly seedless flesh. Delicious flavor makes it excellent for stir-fries and other popular Asian dishes. Upright plants produce early and vigorously.

Solanum melongena 'Millionaire'

- **Use:** You'll feel like you have hit the Jackpot with this Japanese type Eggplant! 'Millionaires' early maturity and voluminous amounts of very slender, nearly black fruit which are virtually without seeds outshine other eggplant varieties by far. This attractive, upright grower will provide much satisfaction and truly enrich your vegetable garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun and try to keep water off the leaves. Water the garden to provide a uniform moisture supply to the crop. Keep the leaves and fruit dry when watering and avoid overhead sprinkler irrigation. Water sufficiently to moisten the soil to a depth of 6 inches. The critical period for moisture is during fruit set and fruit development.
- **Growth:** Space transplants 18" - 24" apart in well drained soil. Rows should be spaced 24" to 36" apart. Keep the soil moist but never soggy. Mulching Eggplant is very beneficial as it helps to retain moisture and keep the soil at an even temperature.
- **Hardiness/Harvest Time:** Annual / Yields in 74 days
- **Fruit** Popular in Italian and Mediterranean dishes. Try serving them grilled, roasted, or stir-fried. Delicious when sliced in half and baked with oil and herbs. Wash fruits, vegetables and herbs thoroughly before eating.
