Spinacia 'Bloomsdale'

- **Use:** Long Standing is an old standard. It's a large, spreading spinach has dark green, savoyed curled leaves. The yield is good, and it is slow to bolt. Plant again in late summer. In mild winter areas, fall plantings yield in early spring.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun and keep the soil evenly moist.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" tall and 4" wide and larger.
- **Hardiness/Harvest Time:** Annual / Yields in less than 40 days
- **Foliage:** Thick, succulent, dark-green, savoyed (crumpled) leaves are very sweet in salads. Bloomsdale is the standard for garden-fresh flavored spinach
