Thymus praecox 'Albiflorus'

- **Use:** There are a great many selections of Thyme grown in gardens, all of them with some degree of spicy fragrance. This flat-growing variety features fragrant light-green leaves, smothered by snow-white flowers in early summer. A slower growing form, but still excellent as a drought-tolerant lawn substitute or for planting between flagstones. Creeping Thyme is easily divided in spring or early fall, and even small pieces will take root and grow. Absolutely beautiful when combined with any of the other creeping purple or red-flowered forms. Attractive to butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. WILL NOT TOLERATE STANDING WATER AND HATES RED CLAY.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 2-4" tall x 10" wide and continues to spread by underground shoots.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fragrant foliage
- **Flower:** Covered completely with white flowers in late spring/early summer. These beautiful white flowers flow like a fresh snow fall in your garden!
