

# Highland Creme Thyme



The Highland Cream Thyme has one of the freshest fragrances you'll find. This plant will fill the air with a citrusy-lemon scent. It offers a fresh thyme flavor that tastes amazing on chicken and pork! It will also jazz up roasted veggies.



## *Thymus praecox* 'Highland Crème'

- **Use:** Variegated edges of this thymus are cream-colored. Evergreen ground hugger with soft pink blooms in summer. Likes good drainage, as do all Thymes, but is otherwise tolerant of any soil condition. Will take moderate foot traffic.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established. Good drainage is key, red clay must be amended with sand and fine rock for best results. No standing water.
- **Growth:** Reaches 2 to 4 inches tall and 6 to 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8, Perennial / Herb
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Its foliage is medium green with variegated yellow margins.
- **Flower:** It blooms in the spring-summertime with petite and soft pink clusters of flowers.
