- <u>Use:</u> Pink Icing[™] has breathtaking foliage colors and large, robust flavored berries. Spring foliage has many shades of pink mixed with blue and deep greens, and turns a stunning iridescent turquoise blue in winter. Plant this variety in decorative patio pots or in the landscape for year-round color and beauty.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Prefers light, acid soils (pH 4.5-5.2) with high organic matter (20-50%) are preferred, unlike most fruit crops.
- **Growth:** Mounded, slightly spreading form; reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-10; Shrub
- <u>Pollination: Although blueberries are self-fertile, cross-pollination</u> produces the best fruit crop (larger berries and larger yields). Therefore, it is best to plant more than one variety that will bloom at the same time.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. stunning peach, pink, orange and emerald green leaves.
- <u>Flower</u>: White bell-shaped flowers appear in spring, leading to an abundant summer crop of blueberries. In most climates, this plant will keep its leaves throughout winter and turns a rich eggplant purple.
