

Seedless Vanessa Grapes



Vitis labrusca x vinifera 'Vanessa Seedless'

- **Use:** Works well for use as an ornamental vine on an arbor or trellis or trailing along fences. Excellent for fresh eating as a sweet dessert grape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** This grape tolerates a wide range of soil conditions, but must have good drainage. Prefers warm Southern sun exposure for best crop. Needs full sunlight and high temperatures to ripen, so plant on southern slopes, the south side of windbreaks, or the south sides of buildings.
- **Growth:** Fast growing vine; grows 20 to 25 ft. each year.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green above and green tinged yellow beneath, the leaves are glossy on both sides, becoming firm and subglaucous at maturity. Bright yellow, red, or orange fall foliage colors. It can be described in one word: stunning
- **Flower/Fruit:** A new, early-mid ripening, red, seedless grape with a sweet, fruity flavor. From Ontario Canada, and one of the hardiest of the red cultivars. Crunchy, non-slipskin texture and excellent fruit quality is what Vanessa brings to the table. Compact clusters of medium-size, ob-long berries. Hardy to minus 20 degrees
