

# Paulk Muscadine



- **Uses:** Fresh Market, Home, U-Pick
- **Fruit Color:** Purple-Black
- **Fruit Size:** Large
- **Fruit Taste:** Sweet
- **Sugar Content:** 16.5-17.5%

## *Vitis rotundifolia* 'Ga. 6-2-26' PPAF

- **Use:** A more recent patented release by the UGA College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, the 'Paulk' Muscadine offers reliable and higher yields of bigger fruit for both home gardeners and growers. It is self-fertile, meaning that it doesn't require a pollinator plant to produce fruit. In the past, only female muscadine cultivars could produce large fruit, and they needed the help of a pollinator plant to do so. Extremely productive, the vigorous vines produce abundant, very large deep purple fruits that ripen mid season and weigh in at an average 15 grams! The fruits have excellent flavor and a dry stem scar so are very easy to pick without damaging them. An exceptionally reliable and easy to grow Muscadine that will please with a bounty of deliciously sweet grapes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Grow in full sun. Muscadine grapes grow well on a wide range of soils but best results are obtained from well-drained sandy loams with a pH of 5.5 to 6.5. They will not tolerate low, wet ground.
- **Growth:** Plant in full sun at 15-20 ft. apart on strong trellises.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10b; Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green above and green tinged yellow beneath, the leaves are glossy on both sides, becoming firm and subglabrous at maturity.
- **Flower/Fruit:** . Extremely productive, the vigorous vines produce abundant, very large deep purple fruits that ripen mid season and weigh in at an average 15 grams! The fruits have excellent flavor and a dry stem scar so are very easy to pick without damaging them. An exceptionally reliable and easy to grow Muscadine that will please with a bounty of deliciously sweet grapes.
