## Alocasia macrorrhiza 'Camouflage Variegata' aka 'Splash'

- <u>Use:</u> This beautiful Alocasia has thinner leaves than others but the colorful splash on the leaves is unlike others. These collector's items aren't easy to find so grab one while we still have them in stock!
- Exposure/Soil: Needs bright, indirect light. It may grow in medium indirect light but you will need to be mindful of how often your plant is watered. Allow plant to dry out slightly before rewatering, but likes high humidity. If your home is dry indoors provide a saucer of pebbles under the plant with water or mist occasionally. Alocasia are known for being prone to spider mites. Spider mites thrive in dry conditions, so keeping your plant somewhere with high humidity is not only good for your plant but also helps to keep spider mites at bay!
- <u>Growth</u>: This little plant wont get much larger than a 12" tall, so if you love the lush look of giant Alocasia but live in a small apartment this is the perfect plant for you. Slow growth.
- Hardiness: Zone 10-11, Houseplant Prefers temps above 60 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Amazing green and creamy-white variegation which is getting more visible with the age of the leaf. Not for human consumption and should be kept away from kids and pets.
- Flower: Not known for their flowers.
