Pink Flamingo Flower/ Anthurium in Glass





This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.

Anthurium andraeanum 'Rosea'

- <u>Use</u>: Anthuriums are popular to give as hostess gifts because of the heart-shaped pink leaf. The often mistaken flower that is actually a leaf is long-lasting and provides an abundance of joy, which could symbolize the host you're gifting. Very easy to grow houseplant or annual to put in your shade planters. Adds a tropical flair to your home.
- Exposure/Soil: Bright light or nearly full sun (not direct or scorching sunshine) is best to maintain strong foliage coloration and vigorous growth indoors. Make sure you don't have chlorine in your water or use filtered water. Prefers high humidity and high temperatures as well. Indoors, mist several times a week to provide added humidity or place in the shower once a month.
- **Growth:** Can grow 2-3' tall and 2-3' wide over time, but a moderate grower
- Hardiness: Zone 10-11 Houseplant, Annual. Bring inside in winter.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Waxy, heart-shaped-spadelike leaves. Not for human or pet consumption.
- **Flower:** Produces a bubblegum pink spathe with a pinkish-cream spadix. Mature plants produce multiple blooms held well above the foliage. The flowers are long lasting and it's not unusual for an Anthurium to be in almost continuous flower. Can also be used as a cut flower
