

Leopard Calathea



Very easy to grow house-plant or annual to put in your shade planters.

Calathea leopardina

- **Use:** Use as a houseplant or unusual annual in your outdoor shade container plantings. One of the easiest to care for Calatheas it is, which differs from most prayer plants in that it doesn't have a rich maroon underside to its leaves and instead is green all over.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Indoors, Calathea is tolerant of lower light conditions making it a fine houseplant. Plant in the Pro-Mix. Make sure you don't have chlorine in your water. Calathea wants high humidity and high temperatures as well. Indoors, mist several times a week to provide added humidity
- **Growth:** Can grow 1-2' tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10 Houseplant, Annual
- **Foliage:** Long, oval leaves which are light green and marked by darker green spotted stripes.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
