

Rosy Prayer Plant



Gorgeous, showy houseplant or showy patio plant in mild weather!

Calathea roseopicta

- **Use:** Cotton candy on a stem anyone? 'Rosy' is a favorite of ours with its bright rose leaves and deep green border. Place it in a white ceramic pot for some extra pop. Like other prayer plants, it's easy to care for and pet friendly.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Bright , indirect light indoors. Shade outdoors. They prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry usually every 7 days indoors. Do not let stand in water. Likes high humidity. Use filtered water.
- **Growth:** Grows very slowly 2-3 feet tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10; Houseplant; Annual; Bring inside in winter.
- **Foliage:** It has a way of changing its color over time, evolving from a deep violet to a soft blush, depending on the light it receives. The large foliage coupled with its dense form make this houseplant worth providing the extra humidity it needs to flourish.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
