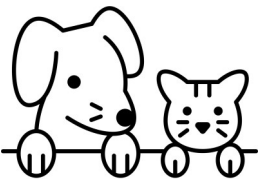


Atlantic Spider Plant



This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.



This plant is considered non-toxic, therefore safe around children and pets.

Chlorophytum comosum 'Atlantic'

- **Use:** This plant, with its long, arching leaves, is ideal for purifying the air in your home while requiring little care. Its resistance to various environments makes it a popular choice among plant lovers who seek both aesthetics and ease of care to enhance their interior decor. One of the easiest houseplants you will ever grow! We have also heard customers bragging that they will come back in the shade garden if established for a season before winter hits. Could be used as a groundcover or in mixed planters in shade.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers a light spot, but not in direct sunlight. Always keep the soil moist, without letting the plant stand in water. In the summer, the plant absorbs more water so water it up to 3 times a week then. In the winter, keep it to once a week at most. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 12-18" tall, and continues to grow in width and hang down.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8a-11b Treated as an Annual and a Houseplant, but many of our customers have success with them coming back as a Perennial outdoors as well, especially if in a protected areas near the home or on a porch. Place 2" of mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. This variety has dark green margins surrounding a cream center stripe, making it similar in appearance to the Variegated Spider plant.
- **Flower:** Single white flowers late spring to summer produce new (spider-like looking) plants on long hanging stems.
