

# Tenelli Bling Crassula



Use in rock container gardens in summer or as a houseplant in a sunny window.



## *Crassula mesembryanthemoides* 'Tenelli'

- **Use:** Part of the Crassulaceae family and are native to South Africa. Their leaves are green-gray and have stems that are hairy. They can reach up to 12-16 inches in height. In the fall and winter, there can be flowers that appear.
- These rare plants would make a great addition to your garden.
- Good for containers and indoors as a houseplant. You can enjoy them outdoors when night temps reach above 50 degrees. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to light shade in a well-drained soil and irrigate regularly to occasionally in spring and summer.
- **Growth:** As the plant matures you can expect it to reach up to 12-16" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual; Very heat tolerant! Bring indoors in winter into a sunny room when temps go below 50 degrees at nite. Hardy to 25 °F.
- **Foliage:** Fuzzy, grey-green, lance-shaped succulent leaves.
- **Flower:** When the plant finally produces flowers you can expect them to be pink from late fall.
