- <u>Use</u>: Super Serie Djix is known for its unique flower shape with downward facing petals. The right cyclamen care will reward you with some of winter's most charming and vibrant bloomers. Cyclamens are known for their petite stature and quaint blooms. When you need a quick addition of colorful flowers to brighten up your home during the fall- winter, grab a few indoor cyclamen to bring a smile indoors.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Provide bright, indirect light indoors. Keep soil consistently moist but not waterlogged. Maintain a cool environment, around 50-60° F (10-15°C). Cyclamens prefer higher humidity levels. Use a well-draining potting mix. They also prefer some humidity so try not to have them near a fireplace or heating vent.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-9" tall and wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9a-11b Houseplant/ Annual (Originates from a bulb) will go dormant in summer, but bulb can be stored and reforced in fall again.
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Pretty green, heart-shaped leaves that often have silver patterns. *Not for animal of human consumption.*
- *Flower*: Their blooms make a debut in early winter to spring, then go dormant during the summer. Plus, she smells fragrant!
