Epipremnum aureum /Scindapsus aureus

- <u>Use</u>: Among the most popular houseplants for their versatility and easy care. They are attractive, durable and easy to grow vines that have smooth, leathery, heart shaped leaves with distinctive marbling alternating along rope-like green stems. Pothos vines are among the top ten air purifying plants for indoor use.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Can tolerate low light conditions, but will cause the variegation to fade. They do best in filtered light, although a little morning sun is permissible. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, but take care not to overwater. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- <u>Growth:</u> Will continue to grow in the basket. make excellent hanging plants, but they will never reach their full potential unless they are allowed to climb upright on a totem pole. Totems give the plant's air roots something to attach to for support.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-11, Annual, Houseplant
- Foliage: Yellow and green heart shaped variegated leaves.
- Flower: No flowers.
