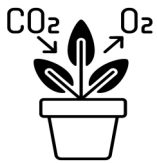


Heart Fern in Deco Pot

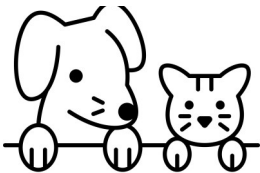

This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.



This plant is considered non-toxic, therefore safe around children and pets.

Hemionitis arifolia

- **Use:** A small, attractive fern with heart-shaped leaves that's popular as a houseplant or terrarium plant. They are a natural with orchids, bromeliads and other rainforest plants. A shower ledge by a window is a good place for a healthy bird's nest fern.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Medium, indirect light near a window (but not in hot sun). They need high humidity levels, even moisture, and medium to lower light conditions to thrive. They can also be grown outdoors in warm, humid states that mimic their native tropical habitats when temps are above 55 degrees outdoors, otherwise keep inside. Feed with a weak fertilizer monthly during the growing season late spring-fall. Water from the base once the top couple of inches of soil is dry and avoid soggy conditions.
- **Growth:** Slow growing 10" tall and wide, but possibly larger with many years of growing.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 11-12, Annual, Houseplant;
- **Foliage:** Smooth, leathery leaves growing on dark stems. The leaves are shaped like an elongated heart or the tip of an arrow, which gives this cute small plant its name.
- **Flower:** No flowers, but spores on undersides of leaves.
