

Alii Ficus



Ficus maclellandii 'Alii'

- **Use:** A sleek and stylish houseplant perfect for adding a modern, tropical touch to any space. Delivering effortlessly strong growth with the added perk of unique olive-toned foliage, it is known for its virtually carefree nature and eye-catching good looks. The ficus tree is known for its longevity, living between 20 to 50 years. Outdoors they can help create a lush, low maintenance look on a shady porch when temps are above 50 degrees at nite.
- **Exposure/Soil:** High light indoors; afternoon shade or shade outdoors. Avoid creating a situation that promotes root rot. In our homes and offices, keep Ficus in a light, well-draining soil. They prefer to be kept on the moist side, but not so wet that it damages the plant. (No standing water in the pot or saucer and increase humidity in the winter around the plant when the heater is running. Draft areas could cause leaf drop.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 2-8' tall or more, but most people keep it shorter with an occasional trim. Could grow up to 60' outdoors in South Florida.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Its large leaves are slender, creating an elegant drooping effect. Not for human or pet consumption.
- **Flowers:** Flowers have little ornamental value.
