


Rattlesnake Plant



This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.



This plant is considered non-toxic, therefore safe around children and pets.

Goeppertia insignis / Calathea lancifolia

- **Use:** These beautiful indoor plants provide a color filled focal point in any room. Use as a houseplant or unusual annual in your outdoor shade container plantings in warmer months. A wonderfully showy houseplant. It has upright, lance-shaped leaves with long wavy edges that form in clumps, spreading slowly over time.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers bright, indirect light. It can tolerate some lower light conditions, but avoid direct sunlight, as it can scorch the leaves. Make sure you don't have chlorine in your water, so using filtered water is best to avoid brown leaf tips. Calathea wants high humidity and high temperatures as well. Prefers high humidity levels. You can increase humidity by misting the leaves with water, using a humidifier, or placing a tray of water near the plant. Do not use leaf shine and filtered water is best.
- **Growth:** Can grow to 30" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10 Houseplant, Annual
- **Foliage:** Wavy rattlesnake shaped leaves, with a deep burgundy underside and vibrant green patterned top side.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
