
Peacock Plant





This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.



This plant is considered non-toxic, therefore safe around children and pets.

Goeppertia/(Calathea) makoyana

- <u>Use</u>: These beautiful indoor plants provide a color filled focal point in any room. Use as a houseplant or unusual annual in your outdoor shade container plantings in warmer months. he stunning leaves in this genera have earnt the name Peacock plant. The leaves open in the day to the sun and close up at night. Plants in this family are know as Prayer Plants as a result.
- Exposure/Soil: Prefers bright, indirect light. It can tolerate some lower light conditions, but avoid direct sunlight, as it can scorch the leaves. Make sure you don't have chlorine in your water, so using filtered water is best to avoid brown leaf tips. Calathea wants high humidity and high temperatures as well. Prefers high humidity levels. You can increase humidity by misting the leaves with water, using a humidifier, or placing a tray of water and gravel underneath the plant. Do not use leaf shine.
- **Growth:** Can grow to 3' tall and wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 10 Houseplant, Annual
- <u>Foliage</u>: It has dark green oval shaped markings and leaf edge over a light green leaf. The underside of the leaf shows the same markings in maroon.
- **Flower:** The flowers are typically insignificant and may bloom throughout the year.
