This plant filters pollutants from the air while releasing oxygen. With this plant in your home, you breathe cleaner air.

Goeppertia (Calathea) pilosa

- <u>Use</u>: New! For the experienced plant collector that wants a new precious plant in the home! A member of the Prayer Plant family, leaves are open during the day but at night the leaves fold upward. A beautiful accent to your space, with bold markings and abundant foliage. Native to Central and South America. These plants are hard to come by, and can be a tad bit of work to maintain, so we don't recommend these for absolute beginners.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Bright, indirect light indoors. Shade outdoors when temps are above 60 degrees. They prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry usually every 7 days indoors. Do not let stand in water. Likes high humidity. Use filtered water to prevent leaf issues from chlorine and fluoride.
- **Growth**: Grows very slowly 1-2 feet tall and wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 10; Houseplant; Annual; Bring inside in winter.
- Foliage: Beautiful, green and yellow patterned, oval leaves.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
